


Inventory of Existing Conditions – Overall

Inventory of Existing Conditions – Airside



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

Developments since the 2010 Master Plan




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Focus Study on the Second Runway

 Conduct a comprehensive study on a potential second runway, considering recent events, updated aviation activity forecasts, and the need for operational continuity









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Develop strategies to enhance airfield safety and improve landside connectivity Expand and modernize terminal facilities to accommodate projected air service demand while preserving the Kona sense of place





KOA Master Plan Goals

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Maximize land use potential through strategic nonaeronautical developments that drive sustainable revenue growth Enhance airport infrastructure to improve readiness and response capabilities for weather disruptions









Develop a phased and feasible approach for master plan projects that allows flexibility for adjustments based on future growth projections Engage with neighboring communities to ensure that the master plan supplements the Kona Community Development Plan






KOA Master Plan Objectives

- Identify measures to enhance safety for both fixed-wing and rotary-wing activities at the airport
- Enhance the passenger experience by evaluating travel paths, improving wayfinding, and modernizing the terminal with expanded amenities, while preserving the Kona sense of place



KOA Master Plan Objectives

- Integrate a second "right-sized" runway into the airport's airside infrastructure to boost operational capacity, continuity, and efficiency
- Enhance landside connectivity by providing additional airport access points, reducing congestion, and improving traffic flow



Master Plan Update



KOA Master Plan Objectives

- 5) Ensure **reliable supply of power and jet fuel** to support future airport functions and operations
- 6) Pursue the development of airport lands and facilities in accordance with grant assurances, leveraging **non-aeronautical developments to generate additional revenue**
- 7) Create a **phased implementation plan** that prioritizes key projects while balancing longterm goals, near-term plans (i.e., Terminal Improvements), cost-effectiveness, and funding availability
- 8) Ensure the master plan **supplements the regional development goals** illustrated in the Kona Community Development Plan, reflecting community values and priorities through effective stakeholder engagement




